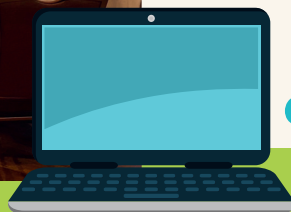

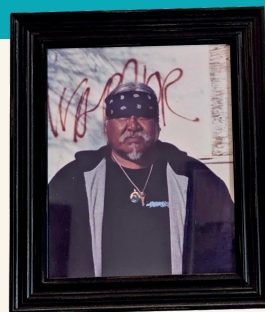

The Stories of Those We Serve

An interview with Bill and his dog, Oscar

I recently had the pleasure of interviewing William “Bill” Pierce, a Prescott Meals on Wheels recipient whose life story is as rich and inspiring as the photographs that line the walls of his living room.

Bill grew up in Arkansas and first came to Arizona during his service in the Air Force. He was stationed in Gila Bend in 1966, and after briefly returning to Arkansas to re-enlist, he eventually made Arizona his permanent home. He later spent 30 years working for APS before retiring in Prescott Valley, where he now lives with his beloved dog, Oscar.

Bill began receiving meals from Prescott Meals on Wheels in 2023. When I asked how he found our program, he shared the story of a recent and profound turning point in his life.

“I had a stroke,” Bill said. “I was married at the time, and they told my wife they didn’t think I was going to make it through the night because my vital organs were shutting down. I’d had a major one.”

Doctors and nurses called him a miracle. Bill had to relearn how to walk, read, speak, and perform countless everyday tasks. “I wanted to say something, but it just wouldn’t come out, and a hundred other things,” he recalled, describing the long and often frustrating process of recovery.

Despite the challenges he has faced, Bill’s stories are full of warmth, humor, and gratitude. He talked about his family, his time in the military, and the many dogs he rescued during his years at APS. He also shared his love for sports, cars, nature, and fresh vegetables.

“I’ve had an interesting life, see my pictures,” he said, gesturing to the walls around us. The frames held images of landscapes, animals, and people, each captured with an evident appreciation for beauty. “I started doing this before I ever retired because I had seen some things,” he explained, referring again to his time in the service. “And I said to myself, that would make a good picture.”

Bill hopes to host a photography show someday, and after seeing his work and hearing the stories behind it, it’s easy to understand why. His perspective on life, shaped by service and resilience, is both humbling and inspiring.

Prescott Meals on Wheels is honored to serve Bill and others like him. Their stories remind us why our work matters and how deeply a simple meal can connect us to our community.
