## Volunteer Spotlight- by Billi Jo Stedman

Meet our Thursday kitchen Volunteers, Bruce and Claudia Greenwood, who joined Prescott Meals on Wheels 3 years ago.

Both Bruce and Claudia were born and raised in Ohio. After Bruce graduated from Allegheny College in Pennsylvania with a degree in Business Administration, he served in the Air Force for 5 years as a Navigator on a C124.

Claudia graduated from DePauw University in Indiana where she studied English Composition and Spanish Literature then went on to receive her Master's degree in English Literature from the University of Michigan. She earned a Doctorate in Composition Theory from Indiana University in Pennsylvania after 20 years of teaching.



How did Bruce and Claudia meet you ask? The summer prior to Claudia's first teaching job in Wilmington, Delaware, Claudia taught Spanish with Bruce's mother.
